Online Course for Coaches Level 1

Background

World Archery have set up a dedicated learning platform that enables the initial training of coaches through an online course.

The course is designed to introduce coaches to the theory behind the level 1 coaching qualification, which is then be supplemented by attendance at a practical course intended to put the initial learning into practice.

It might be of interest to those as well who do not plan to attend the practical course but are interested of the theoretical knowledge offered through online course.

Course Contents

The course has a total of eight (8) modules, covering the following subjects:

Who can have access to the course?

- 1. Any coach who wishes to take the World Archery Coaching Level 1 course.
 - a. The online course is a pre-requisite to attendance at a level 1 practical course.
 - b. Attendance at a level 1 practical course must take place within two years of completion of the online course (extension is given to those who planned to take the practical course in 2020-2021).
- 2. Any coach endorsed by their national federation who wishes to take only the online course without the intention of passing the practical course.
 - a. These coaches will not receive official qualification, only online course certificate.

How is access arranged?

In order to arrange access, the Member Association needs to request access codes. Link to request for codes is available in Extranet. The codes will be provided to federation by email within two (2) weeks. No codes will be provided to individuals contacting World Archery office directly.

What is the charge?

There is a charge for each access, depending on the number of access codes requested:

1-19 codes: 15 CHF/each

20-99 codes: 12 CHF/each

100+ codes: 10 CHF/each
Each Member Association will be charged at the end of the year, unless requested differently.

What will happen after access code is provided?

Each code can be used by one person and is valid for one year since it's issue. The Member Association is responsible for managing the codes that were provided to them.

The participant will need to go to https://education.worldarchery.org and will need to provide personal details with the first log-in. The code is needed to enrol to course.

Does passing online course give participants a certification?

Yes, a certificate of passing the online course is provided upon passing the final online exam. However, participants does not gain a coaching qualification with passing only the online course. This is the first part towards gaining the World Archery level 1 coaching qualification. The second part of the qualification is through the attendance at a World Archery level 1 practical course.
