**Final registration that will differ for more than 4 archers according to preliminary registration will have a penalty fee of 150 USD to be paid to the OC at the moment of arriving at the event.**

A Member Association which made entries in FORS and does not participate will be invoiced for the number of entries entered in the system, unless the MA inform FITA and the OC latest one week prior to the event that they are not be able to attend it.

# Additional Information

**Time:** Local time is GMT (GMT +1 from last Sunday in March to Saturday before last Sunday in October).

**Electricity:** 240 volts, 50Hz. Flat three-pin plugs are standard.

**Money:** The currency is the pound (GBP), which is divided into 100 pence. ATMs are available in all towns and Visa, MasterCard and American Express are widely accepted; visitors with other cards should check with their credit card companies in advance. Foreign currency can be exchanged at bureaux de change and large hotels, however better exchange rates are likely to be found at banks. Travellers cheques are accepted in all areas frequented by tourists; they are best taken in Pounds Sterling to avoid additional charges.

**Language:** English and Welsh are the official languages.

**Entry requirements for Americans:** US travelers must hold a valid passport; a visa is not required. UK Immigration officials will decide on length of stay up to six months depending on reason for travel.

**Entry requirements for Canadians:** Canadian nationals must hold a valid passport; a visa is not required. UK Immigration officials will decide on length of stay up to six months depending on reason for travel.

**Entry requirements for Australians:** Australian nationals must hold a valid passport; a visa is not required. UK Immigration officials will decide on length of stay up to six months depending on reason for travel.

**Entry requirements for Irish nationals:** Irish nationals do not require a visa or a passport to enter the UK, but if travelling from a country other than Ireland, the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, then a passport is required.

**Entry requirements for all other nationals:** For up to date passport and visa requirements please check the following website: <http://www.ukvisas.gov.uk>

**Passport/Visa Note:** If a visa is not required, travelers should hold a return or onward ticket, or proof of funds for the duration of stay. Passports must be valid for the period of intended stay in the UK; nationals of the EU require a passport valid on arrival. All nationals of non-EEA member states travelling to the UK for more than six months require an Entry Clearance visa.

**Road Charges:** If traveling by road to Wales from England via the M4 motorway please remember that a Toll is payable for all vehicles. Charges change from time to time so ensure you have sufficient money with you to meet these payments.

**Health:** There are no specific health risks associated with travel to the UK and food and water can be considered safe. The British National Health Service is excellent; emergency treatment is free to visitors, but charges are made for routine medical care. A number of countries have reciprocal health agreements with the UK including Australia, New Zealand and EU countries. Visitors from other countries (including Canada, South Africa and the US) are advised to take out good medical insurance.

**Communications:** The international country dialing code for UK is +44. The outgoing code is 00, or 048 for Northern Ireland, followed by the relevant country code (e.g. 001 for the United States). There is a wide range of city/area codes in use. Mobile phones work throughout the country; the network operators use GSM 1800 networks, which may not be compatible with some dual-band US cell phones. Internet cafes are available in major towns and cities, train stations and airports.

The climate in Wales is like the rest of the United Kingdom - highly unpredictable. Winters are wet, though days can sometimes be crisp and sunny, and summers are usually warm, with plenty of sunshine. Springtime (March to May) is a popular time to travel to Wales, with mild weather and plenty of flowers to enjoy, though sporadic rain and wind is possible. Winter temperatures average around 37°F (3°C), while summer temperatures average around 77°F (25°C).
