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## PRELIMINARY & FINAL REGISTRATION

All entries, accommodation reservations, transport needs, flight arrival/departure information and visa invitation letter requests are to be completed using the World Archery Registration Online System WAREOS <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport>. This system handles the entire registration process for this event. No information related to entry forms, hotel reservations or transportation forms received outside the official registration website (WAREOS) will be accepted.

Member associations can log in to WAREOS at <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport> with the username and password assigned by World Archery. After entering WAREOS, selecting the event from the list will allow a member association to register their athletes. Select/press the “Entries” button to see the list of categories in the event. Select/press the “category” to enter the athlete and official numbers/details of those participating in that event. A WAREOS User Manual can be downloaded in PDF format (English) upon login.

A maximum number of 4 athletes per country can be registered into each category of the event. Preliminary entries must be completed using WAREOS.

Member Associations can only use WAREOS to make any changes, amendments or cancellations to entries and will be able to do so at any time. An email will automatically notify the Organising Committee and Member Association of any changes made in WAREOS.

Member associations that have penalty fees outstanding from 2026 will need to pay these penalty fees before being eligible to enter and compete.

Any entries received after the final registration deadline will be refused. Only substitutions will be allowed.

Entries and substitutions received after the deadlines are subject to penalties as clearly stated in the rule book and the invitation documents of World Cups and World Championships. A Member Association that has made final entries in WAREOS and does not participate will be invoiced for the number of entries entered in the system as well as any other booking they made through the platform (including but not limited to accommodation, transportation, and any other extras the Member Association has booked through the platform).

- Booking outside of WAREOS will incur a penalty as listed in the registration fee section.

## IMPORTANT!

The 50% down payment due date for all teams willing to participate is April 3<sup>rd</sup>. The absence of complete payment of the downpayment by the deadline will result in a cancellation of the pre-booking on WAREOS.

## ACCOMMODATION CANCELLATION COSTS

Please note that, according to the contracts signed with the accommodation services providers, in case you have any room cancellation **between April 7<sup>th</sup> and June 5<sup>th</sup>, 75% of the accommodation fee will not be refundable.**

June 5<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for the LOC to pay 100% for all booked rooms at that time, so **any cancellation or changes after that date will not be refundable at all.**







## COMPETITION VENUES

### MAIN COMPETITION VENUE – VALLEHERMOSO STADIUM

Located in the heart of the city of Madrid, Vallehermoso Stadium will host the following events:

- Official practice day
- Qualification round
- Individual elimination round (up to quarter finals)
- Men & Women teams elimination round (up to bronze medal matches)
- Mixed teams elimination round (up to semifinals)



Bow storage area, LOC, World Archery and Media offices will also be available at Vallehermoso Stadium.

Grandstands are available for free for spectators, from Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> to Friday 10<sup>th</sup>

In the surroundings of the stadium, parking in the street is a regulated paying service:

- Monday to Friday (except bank holidays: from 9 to 21:00)
- Saturdays: from 9:00 to 15:00

Maximum parking time during regulated service is four hours in blue parking areas or two hours in green parking areas (more expensive than blue ones, as they are dedicated to the neighborhood residents).

### PRACTICE FIELD – CANTARRANAS SPORTS COMPLEX

A 64 targets practice field will be available for participants, starting Sunday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, till Saturday July 13<sup>th</sup>.

The LOC will provide a shuttle bus service connecting Vallehermoso and Cantarranas, while competition is being held in Vallehermoso. The days before competition starts and those after last competition day in Vallehermoso, athletes will be picked up and dropped back from / to their accommodation buildings.



## MEDAL MATCHES VENUE – PUENTE DEL REY ESPLANADE

Located at Madrid Río Park, between the palatial Vargas Mansion and Huerta de la Partida Gardens, “Puente del Rey” Esplanade is right next to one of the entrances to Casa de Campo Park.

This open-air space hosts all kinds of performances, from music, dance, flamenco and zarzuela to musicals, sport events and much more.



The bridge here was built at the beginning of the 19th century and was designed by royal architect Isidro González Velázquez, a student of Juan de Villanueva. In its early days, the bridge could only be used by the king, who crossed it to access Casa de Campo Park from the Royal Palace. When the park was opened to the general public in 1931, the bridge was widened. Today, it serves as one of the main entrances to Madrid Río Park.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation will be provided from the official arrival / departure points to the official accommodation buildings, starting two days before the official practice day, until two days after the closing day.

Participants arrival / departure transportation service costs 60€ per person (one way).

Free local transportation will be provided between the official accommodation buildings, practice and competition venues. Transport timetables will be confirmed at a later stage.

Should flight arrival details change at the last minute, please contact the Organizing Committee, as soon as possible, using the details indicated in the team managers’ booklet.



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## VISA

Please check the [conditions for your entry in Spain, according to the national laws](#).

All participants who need an entry visa to Spain, will be required to complete the Visa Support sections in WAREOS by no later than May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026).

All the information about visas for your stay in Spain [can be consulted HERE](#).

It is the applicants' responsibility for supplying the necessary information, ensuring all details are up to date, correct and submitted by the deadlines specified.

In addition, all participants that require a visa are kindly requested to supply a copy of their latest/valid passport. Copies of each application can be uploaded on WAREOS. All passport copies and personal details entered/uploaded to WAREOS will be held securely and in the strictest of confidence and not shared with other parties.

It is in your best interest to fill out visa applications as soon as possible to ensure eligibility for the event.

### WATER AND FRUIT

Fruit and water stations will be available at the competition and practice field.

No glasses will be provided in order to avoid waste, so participants are encouraged to bring their own bottles to be filled at the stations.

### FOREIGN TOURIST ASSISTANCE SERVICE

The [Foreign Tourist Assistance Service \(SATE\)](#) offers personal assistance to tourists who need to visit a police station for whatever reason.

Assistance is provided by a qualified team at the official tourism agency or by police officers. They help tourists lodge complaints or fill in forms.

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## EMERGENCY SERVICES AND HEALTHCARE

Each participant is responsible for ensuring they have the correct travel and medical insurance before they arrive at the event.

The Spanish National Health System comprises a widespread network of hospitals and healthcare centres that spans across the country. **Healthcare centres** provide primary care, while specialist service is available in **hospitals**, to which patients must be referred by a doctor. In addition, hospitals and some healthcare centres have an **emergency service**.

If you're an EU citizen, you and your family are eligible for medical care, so that you don't have to return to your country of origin for treatment. However, you should get the [European Health Insurance Card \(EHIC\)](#) in your country, or any equivalent document proving that you have medical insurance in a member state, since this will entitle you to prompt medical care wherever you are.

If you don't have this card (or an equivalent document), you'll still get immediate medical assistance, though you may be fully charged for it. You may claim a refund from your health insurance company, according to the medical costs applicable in the country where you received treatment.

### Medicines

Medicines in Spain must be bought at pharmacies, which you'll easily spot by their green cross. Regardless of the time and the area where you are, you'll always find one on duty, open round the clock. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

### Emergencies

In case of emergency (ambulance, fire and rescue, police), call 112, a toll-free number that works 24/7 across the EU, Spain included. The 112-call center immediately identifies the caller's location. It has interpreting services covering as many as 80 languages.

There are many hospitals quite close to the competition fields.

## INTERNET

Free internet will be provided in all official accommodation buildings.

WiFi network will be available to allow access to results in Vallehermoso stadium.

Madrid provides the Hyundai Archery World Cup circuit the chance to dive into a city plenty of choices. Madrid touristic offer is huge and diverse, and everyone will find their own way to enjoy it.



Madrid has plenty of art! You can find it on every corner and in every wall of its picturesque neighborhoods. Madrid downtown beautiful buildings and monuments whisper the visitors about their centuries of rich history.

If you love paintings, **El Prado Museum** is certainly one of the most impressive galleries in the World. If you are more into modern art, you should visit **Reina Sofía Museum**, exhibiting iconic paintings such as “*El Guernica*” (Picasso), together with master pieces of great artists like Dalí or Miró.

Close to those two very famous museums, the **Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum** will guide the visitor through the history of western art since the 13th century, exhibiting paintings of Van Eyck, Rembrandt, Monet, Degas, Van Gogh, Gauguin...

Good live music is one of the most iconic features in Madrid, with hundreds of music bars scheduling concerts 365 days a year, big arenas bringing the most popular national and international bands to Madrid and massive music festivals when the good weather arrives. One of the biggest in the World, **MadCool music festival** will be happening in Madrid while the Hyundai AWC is taking place (July 10th to 13th), with Alanis Morissette, Kaiser Chiefs, Iggy Pop and Kings of Lion, among many others, on the line up. **Noches del Botanico** music festival is an excellent option to enjoy great concerts in a wonderful venue, quite close to the AWC main competition field.

Besides, musical theatre in Madrid is one the most recognized worldwide, turning to be the third destination in the world, with more than three million tickets sold per year, behind New York and London.

The gastronomy of Madrid is something that you cannot miss neither. Consequently, the Member Association who wishes to register to an event, and book some or all associated extras proposed by the local organizing committee acknowledges that they are fully aware present terms and conditions are accepted by entering information in WAREOS.

Any Member Association declares that it is entitled to enter a contractual relationship with the Local Organising Committee of the event, in accordance with these terms and conditions.

The Local Organising Committee commits itself to communicate, within reason, to its potential clients the greatest information available on the following topics:

Information on the methods of

payment and reimbursement conditions.

### Article 1: Entirety

The platform <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/wareos/> is the propriety of, has been designed and created and is managed by World Archery Federation at Lausanne, Switzerland, and put at the disposal of the Local Organising Committee to facilitate registration to World Archery events.

The present terms and conditions include any and all rights and obligations of the parties. No single, specific, or general term or condition that may appear on documentation sent, given, or handed over to a Member Association will alter, replace, or complete parts of or the entirety of these terms and conditions

World Archery reserves the right to modify at any time and without any preliminary notification of any kind these terms and conditions.

### Article 2: Object

The present terms and conditions define the rights and obligations of the parties in relation to the registration made through the platform <https://extranet.worldarchery.sport/wareos/> of services offered by the Local Organising Committee in the scope of the event it has been set for.

### Article 3: Contractual documents

The present terms and conditions and the registration process make up the contractual documents between the parties.

### Article 4: Electronic signature:

The Member Association's entering registration information is the electronic signature which is binding between the parties in the same sense as a handwritten signature would be.

### Article 5: Registration Confirmation – Contract

The contract is validated as soon as the Member Association has entered its preliminary registration by entering information in WAREOS. A modification of the registration is possible until the deadline for registration set in the document. Modifications may be subject to penalty fees.

### Article 6: Prices

The official prices are listed in the “Policies and Procedures Athletes, officials and team management”, the invitation package prices will be based on the official price list, converted to the currency elected by the LOC for invoicing (CHF, EUR, or USD).

### Article 7: Payment methods



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All payments shall be made by bank transfer to the organising committee respecting the stated deadlines, with all bank charges paid by the Member Association. For any open invoices that are not settled 21 days prior the beginning of the event, the Local Organising committee will be entitled to charge a 5% surcharge on all open amounts. Any payments received cash by World Archery on behalf of the organising committee will incur a 10% additional service fee, to be paid to World Archery.

## Article 8: Payment deadlines and refunds

After the preliminary's entry deadline, the downpayment of 50% shall not be reimbursable. After the final deadlines of registration mentioned in this document, Member Association will not be entitled to any refund, and all remaining unpaid amounts shall be paid to the Local Organising Committee.

Failure to do so, will results in an immediate suspension of the Member Association, who will be set as not in good standing on the day of the official practice of the event, and so until the full amount is paid to the LOC.

## Article 9: Availability of services

## Article 10: Force-majeure

None of the two parties will have failed in their respective contractual obligations if their execution is delayed or prevented by a case of force-majeure. Cases considered to be a force majeure are extraordinary events or circumstances beyond the control of the parties, such as a war, strike, riot, crime, or an event described by the legal term "act of God" (e.g., flooding, earthquake, volcano eruption, etc). However, force majeure is not intended to excuse negligence or other malfeasance of a party, as where non-performance is caused by the usual and natural consequences of external forces, or where the intervening circumstances are specifically contemplated. The party experiencing a force

majeure must notify in writing with 24 hours after becoming aware of the occurrence. The parties will then, within 7 business days examine, unless the force majeure prevents it, if and how the contractual obligations will be met.
