17:30 awarding ceremony and prize draw (The grand prize in the draw is **Hoyt recurve bow**)

Competition format

The competition is open for recurve, compound, barebow and longbow archers.

- Ranking round will be shot with 6 arrows.
- Robin rounds will be shot with 3 arrows.
- Mixed team duels will be shot with 2 arrows.
- The shooting will take place from one shooting line.
- The shooting time is 30 seconds per arrow.

Robin rounds (RR)

- Individual Robin round event is held for U13, U15, U18, U21 and 50+ classes, **if there are at least 4 athletes in their age group.**

Mixed team event

- Recurve, compound, barebow, longbow mixed team (1 man + 1 woman).
- Mixed team event is held, **if there are at least 4 teams in their class.**
- Mixed teams can be formed of people, who **live in the same country** and there can be an unlimited number of mixed teams per country.

NB! Mixed teams will be formed automatically after the ranking round. If you wish to put together certain mixed teams, they must be registered **before** the opening of the competition.

Awarding

- Winners of mixed team event and individual Robin rounds will be awarded with **specially designed medals**, diplomas and prizes donated by sponsors.
- After the awards ceremony is the traditional **prize draw** (The grand prize in the draw is **Hoyt recurve bow**) and photo session will take place.

Entry fee

- Entry fee for U21 and Men/Women is **50 euros** per athlete.
- Entry fee for U13, U15, U18 and 50+ is **40 euros** per athlete.

- The date of registration is considered to be the date of the bank transfer. In case you have done both - payment and filled in registration form - organizers will contact You.
